

Number: 7

The children will spend the day doing lots of activities associated with the number 7. We will make our own books about the number 7 and experiment with sand paper number sevens and making crayon rubbings from them.

We will learn the Seven Silly Snowmen chant, play a Number Seven Matching Game, and create a Number 7 Collage during Art Time.

My Number 7 Book, Pg. 16 - 18

Materials Needed:

Give each child a Number 7 Book. Help the children to cut out the snowflakes and pages. Or have them cut out ahead of time. Invite the children to glue the correct number of snowflakes to each page. Help them staple their books along the left edge and read them out loud. Count the snowflakes as you read.

Number 7 Collage

Materials Included:

Materials Needed:

7 Items to share from each child

Glue

Give each child a Number 7 Collage Sheet and a Number 7 Collage Items. Then ask each child to give their 7 items to one child. They can share with whoever they want but when done each child should have another child's 7 items for their collage.

Now invite the children to glue their 7 items on their collage and fill in the number 7 collage with the collage items so that there are lots of 7 items on their paper.

After they dry hang their papers up for all to see!

Invite the children to join you at the table. Give each of them a number seven, piece of paper and crayon. Show them how to make a crayon rubbing of the number 7 by placing it under the paper and coloring on top.

Chant the words to Seven Silly Snowmen getting a bit louder with each line. Continue until the children have memorized the chant.



